

Surgical Discharge Check-List

- o E-collar is on patient
- o Print <u>Surgery Report</u> from clinic email
 - o Assure all postoperative items have been completed on Surgery check-list
 - o Place in patient medical record
- o Download Discharge instructions from clinic email
 - o Update Medication section with names and dosages of Go-Home meds
 - o Print Discharge instructions and also place a copy in patient medical record
- o Catheter has been removed
- o Incision/Bandage is clean, dry, intact
- o Patient is Awake, Ambulatory and Absent of pain
- o Verify patient bill is complete and ready for check out
- o <u>Go-Home medications</u> placed in patient bag
 - o Explain each medication to owner (why they are on it and possible side effects)
 - o Tell owner when to give the next dose of each medication
- o Give Owner printed Discharge Instructions
- o Explain highlights of discharge instructions;
 - o Confinement
 - <u>o Cone</u>
 - o Care of Incision
- o Ask if the owner has any questions???
- o Schedule their next surgical progress examination
